Writing this newsletter is so much more positive that the two previous years, I am now able to invite you to sports days, summer fairs and leavers services which covid restrictions did not allow us to do last year.

A Star Sports

Following recommendation from a parent I have secured 3 weeks of sports sessions for our children led by A Star Sports. They are a private company who will come in and deliver PE lessons alongside our staff to our children. Each week they will access a different sporting discipline. They will run each Monday, starting on 13th June. All children are to wear their PE kits on this day. It is hoped that in September, the company will deliver a session after school each week.

Please note the PE kit days for all children is now Monday, the outdoor learning days are

Class 1 – Friday

Class 2 – Friday

Class 3 – Wednesday

Class 4 – Thursday

Class 4 will be swimming on Tuesdays and need their PE kit. We appreciate that white PE t.shirts may get a little grubby so are happy with an alternative plain t.shirt to be worn for outdoor learning if necessary.

Sun cream

Sun cream should be applied before school and this should last throughout the day. If you are not confident that your sun cream is sufficient to last the day you can send a bottle in with your child in a clearly labelled clear bag but this will need to stay in school until the end of the summer term and will not be sent home daily or weekly – this is in line with our risk assessment which has limitations on what is brought in from home. Staff will supply your child with a blob of sun cream equivalent to that of a 50p piece for the children to apply themselves, staff are not permitted to apply sun cream to children.

Structures for September

I am pleased to confirm the class structures and staffing for September. You will notice that the structure for the morning is going to be slightly different to the afternoon. During the morning we will focus our work on discrete teaching of Maths and English, boosting and supporting children



with their basic skills. In the afternoon, children will return to their age groups where the learning is more thematic/independent.

Morning classes

Class 1 – Nursery, Reception and Year 1

Class 2 – Year 2, Year 3 and Year 4*

Class 3 – Year 5 and Year 6 with some Year 4* children.

*we will notify current Year 3 parents which class their child will be working in during the mornings in the next couple of weeks but we are taking both friendship groups and academic maturity into consideration.

Afternoon classes

Class 1 – Reception, Year 1 and Year 2

Class 2 – Year 3 and Year 4

Class 3 – Year 5 and Year 6.

We have moved some staff around to ensure that the children do not have too many different teachers. The teacher for Class 1 will be Miss Smith who is currently full time in Y Waun and had taught Foundation Phase for many years. Class 2 will have Miss Prosser full time who they all currently know so well and Class 3 will be split with Mr Johnson in the mornings and Mrs Newton in the afternoons.

All of our classes have been carefully planned to allow staff across the federation to work together, recognising staff strengths.

Moving up day – transition to a new class

On Thursday 30th June all children will have the opportunity to spend the day in their new class with their new teachers. We recognise this move be daunting for some children, where others are so excited by it. To make our transitions smoother we will be working on ensuring that an accurate picture of your child is known before they start class in September and we want your help. At the end of the week we will send home an A4 piece of paper for you, as parents, to complete about your child based on what they tell you about school. This information will be used with work from the day to ensure the teacher has a greater understanding of what makes your child tick and also what pushes the wrong buttons! Please can they be sent back into school by Monday 27th June. On Thursday 30th June, our current Nursery children will be able to stay all day and will have a school dinner.

Forces Fitness

Children are to come to school in PE kits on 6th July. We have received funding relating to forces families and they are coming in to deliver military command tasks, tyre pulls and a team game during the afternoon and they will then stay on with the cadets to operate an activity at the fair.

Summer Fair

A group of parents met earlier this week to plan for this event which will take place on Wednesday 6th July starting at 3.15pm. We have lots of stalls for children to take part in as well as each class running their own stall. On Friday 1st July children are invited to come to school in non-uniform in exchange for tombola prizes for the fair. (please be mindful that Foundation phase have got outdoor learning this day when choosing your clothes!) Please can we also ask for donations of cakes for our cake stall to come to school on the day.

We want to make this a community event and would welcome people to have stalls. If you are interested in a stall please contact the office and we will let you know the details.

Are any of your workplaces are in a position to offer a prize for our raffle, if anyone works in a setting where a voucher can be donated we would be most grateful. Another suggestion was a rainbow stall. This will be a 50p or £1 stall for all new products. We ask for children to bring in a new item to sell on this stall of a particular colour. It can be anything – eg yellow duster,

blue toothbrush, red car, purple bubble bath, orange hair clips etc. Please can we ask for you to follow the colours suggested where possible




Year 6 bowling
