As you know everything is very new and exciting for us this term as we are getting used to new routines and everyone is finding their feet! I am happy to report that the children are settling in well and making a great start to their topics this term.

Language: We will be using the story 'The Owl Who was Afraid of the Dark' as our class story. From this we will be working on writing our own newspaper reports, creating storyboards and conducting our own research on barn owls. I will also be setting the children an exciting coding challenge on the computers to help Plop navigate his way around the forest!

Maths: This term will be focussing on developing our number skills and learning some of our times tables. We will be carrying out different maths investigations and continuing to develop strategies to add and subtract in our heads. We have already looked at number lines and used our skills to create a timeline in our topic books!

Welsh: We will be using the programme Pod Antur to develop our Welsh communication skills. This term we will be refreshing personal information and learning how to talk about our news.

Topic: As you know our topic this term is The Celts and The Romans. We are all very excited about our trip to the Deva Experience in Chester. Through this topic the children will develop their history skills and will have the opportunity to find out where The Celts and Romans lived, what they wore and how they came to live in Chester. The children will use their mapping skills to show where the Romans came from and the different countries they invaded. I am really looking forward to designing and making Celtic shields with children very soon.

Science: Our first science topic this term is Healthy living. We will be looking at ways to keep our bodies healthy and we will be planning investigations to find out which orange is the juiciest? After half term we will be looking at Magnets and the children will have an opportunity to design and make their own magnetic board games.

P.E: This term our P.E sessions are every Friday afternoon. We will be using the hall and working on our ball skills. I really enjoy teaching P.E and I'm excited to develop the childrens' skills using different circuits and team building activities.
